Westnet’s NBN plans start from \$49.95 per month for minimum speeds of 12Mbps and come with a ‘Turbo pack’ option to boost speeds up to 100Mbps if desired.

Westnet’s innovative range of BoB™ modems will work seamlessly on the NBN, making set-up on the new network quick and easy.

Westnet’s CEO, Michael Malone, said he has always been a strong supporter of the National Broadband Network.
